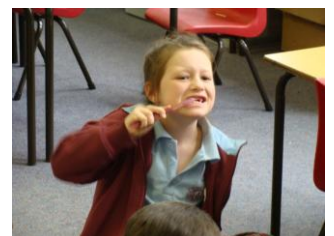
Author's Visit Successful
