It's that time of year again for Yr 6 at Railway Town Public School!

Year 6 student will be participating in a program called TREC-Taking Rural kids Education into Community. This program links with the University Department of Rural Health to provide engagement and career aspirations for our students. The students will participate in a number of activities:

"A life in a day" where students will experience a lifetime in a day, visiting Broken Hill High School, University and the Hospital, following the progression of education into the work force.

"Careers Day" where students will have the opportunity to spend some time in different careers and interviewing people in the community

"Final Product" where student will collate the information they have collected and taken from these experiences to create something to remember.

On 29th March 2012, student will complete stage 1 of the program- "A Life in a day". Students will leave primary school and attend a session at Broken Hill High School, clinical skills at the University Department of Rural Health and have a tour of the hospital. The students have been informed of the TREC program and are very excited.

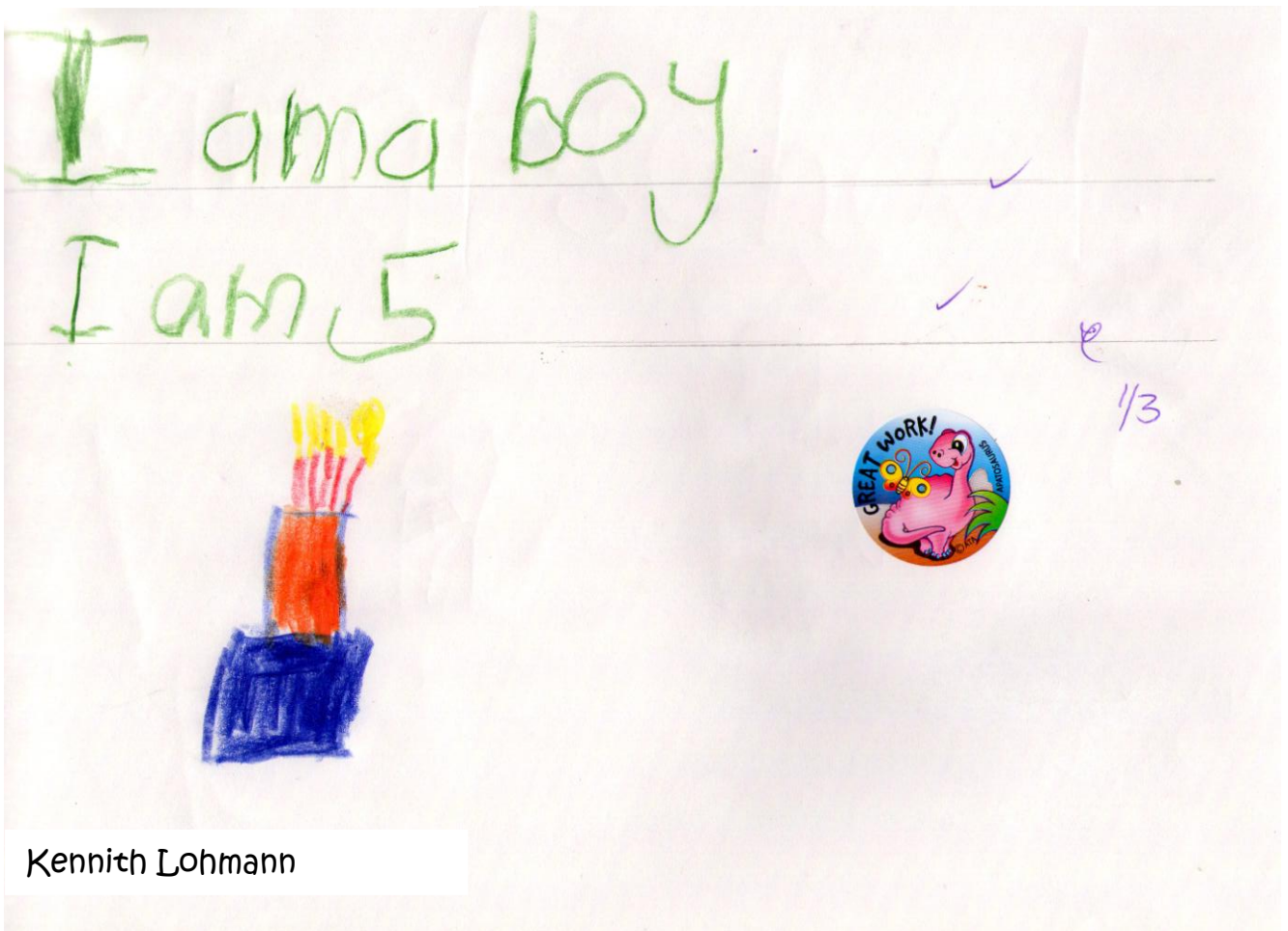
