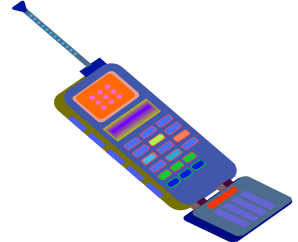
Helpers still required
