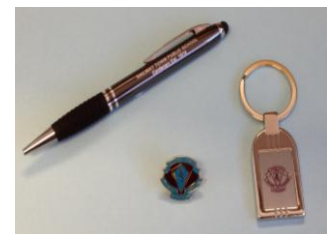
PRESENTATION NIGHT RAFFLE TICKETS
