Facebook

A few incidences have occurred involving students and Facebook. Facebook has issued the following in regard to student's age requirements and the legalities of their privacy terms.

22 Apr 2010 ... **"No information from children under age 13"**. If you are under age 13, please do not attempt to register for Facebook or provide any personal information about yourself to us. If we learn that we have collected personal information from a child under age 13, we will delete that information as quickly as possible. If you believe that we might have any information from a child under age 13, please contact: www.facebook.com/policy.php **Facebook requires everyone to be at least 13 years old before they can create an account. Creating an account with false info is a violation of our terms. This includes accounts registered on the behalf of someone under 13.**
