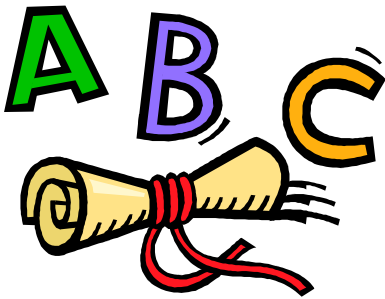
### *Sacraments in the Catholic Church*
