On Thursday 12th September primary students who would like to play cricket on Saturdays are asked to come along to our nets at 4pm and try out.



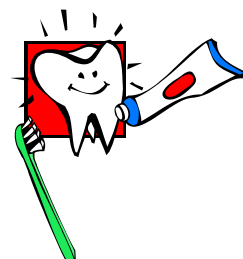

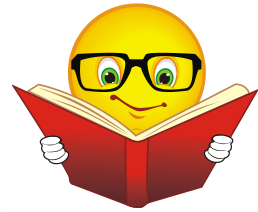
