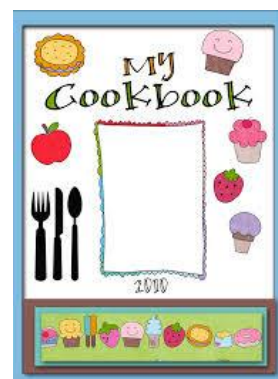

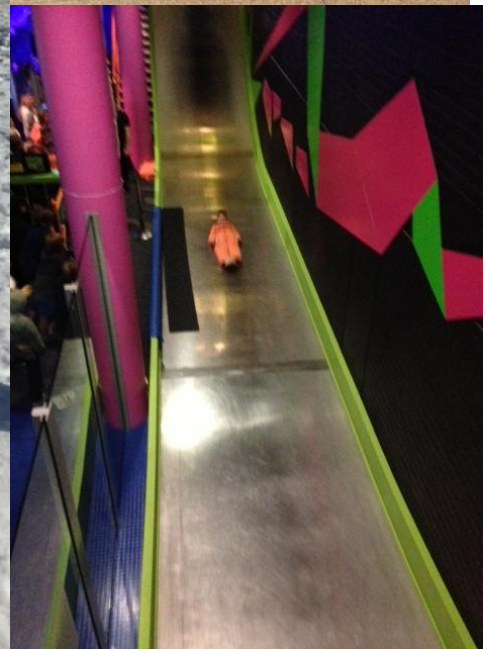

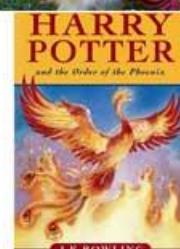
# BOOK WEEK
