'Extravaganza'

The combined schools of the Broken Hill area are holding an 'Extravaganza' titled the Far West Regional Talent Show to raise money for our local hospital on the 1st and 2nd of September (Week 8, Term 3) at the Broken Hill Civic Centre. Each school is providing two items to perform and students of Railway Town in Year 2, Senior Choir and Super Dance Troupe will be performing at the show. There will be 3 performances in total, two evening and one matinee, with local schools performing in all shows.

On Tuesday 1st of September, students will be required to attend a full dress rehearsal for their items. Students will be picked up and returned to school on the rehearsal day. The practice is on the 1st September, as well as the matinee show on 2nd September. Travel for these performances will be by bus, the cost will be covered by the school. For the evening performances, parents need to drop their children off.

Tickets for the shows will be \$25 for a family of 2 adults and 2 children. Individual adult tickets will be \$10 and students will be \$5. Tickets will go on sale 17th of August, 2 weeks before the performance. These tickets can be purchased online from the council's website, at the Civic Centre or at the door at the performances. Tickets are limited so an early purchase would be recommended.

For those students involved in the local netball competition on Tuesday evenings, it would be advisable that your child inform their teams promptly of their non-availability for games during those times.

Performance 1: Tuesday 1st September - doors open at 6pm and **show starts at 6.30pm**

Performance 2: Wednesday 2nd September - doors open at 12pm and **show starts at 12.30pm**

Performance 3: Wednesday 2nd September - doors open at 6pm and **show starts at 6.30pm**

Drinks and refreshments will be provided during the 20 minute intermission for all performances.
