SRC Induction

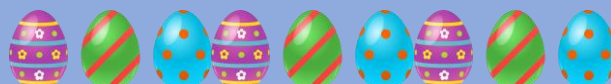
Thank you to all parents who came to the SRC Induction, it was nice to see such a large group. I hope you enjoyed the luncheon provided. Attached are some pictures of the day.

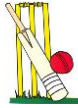
